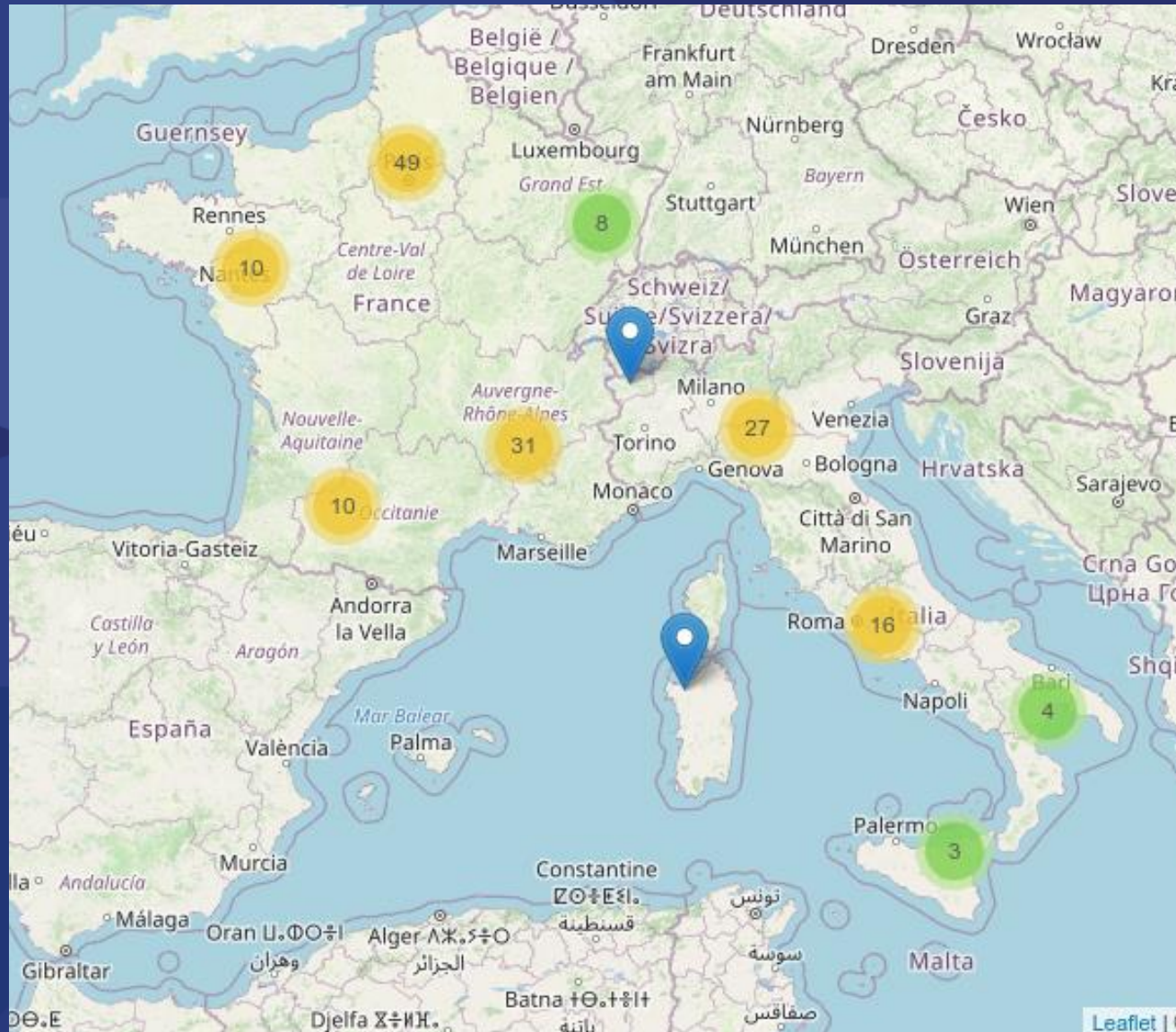

CentraleSupélec is the fruit of the 2015 merger of two historical institutions: Ecole Centrale des Arts et Manufactures (Ecole Centrale Paris, 1829) and Ecole Supérieure d'Electricité (Supélec, 1894). Its innovative general engineering curriculum brings together the best of each school's savoir-faire to train highly qualified executives and researchers for both public and private sectors of business and research. CentraleSupélec graduates are executives and entrepreneurs capable of tackling challenges of the 21st century. CentraleSupélec is a founding member of Université Paris-Saclay. Their shared goal is to become a world leader in engineering sciences and systems engineering.

Université Paris-Saclay. Its research units focus on 10 scientific fields: Industrial Engineering, Economics and Management, Applied Physics; Materials Science and Process Engineering; Mechanical Engineering; Applied Mathematics; Computer Science; Control, Telecommunications; Signal Processing; and Electrical and Electronic Engineering. The School's research involves multi-disciplinary projects, in collaboration with international academic partners and with close links to companies.

STRENGTHS

- CentraleSupélec is tightly connected to innovation and entrepreneurship: 150 industrial partners, 16 research and training chairs, 1 start-up incubator, a network of 35,000 alumni worldwide.

UNIVERSITÉ DE BORDEAUX

BORDEAUX



The University of Bordeaux is a multidisciplinary, research-focused, international institution. Ranked within the top 12 universities in France for the quality of its academic courses and research, the University of Bordeaux was awarded the "Initiative of Excellence" by the French government in 2011, and was one of the first universities to obtain confirmation of this program in 2016. It welcomes more than 57,000 students, of which almost 2,000 are doctoral students and 7,200 are international students. Around 5,900 staff members are employed by the University, of which 4,000 are academic and research staff.

MAIN PROGRAMMES OF STUDY

Students may choose from a multitude of curricula that lead to national degrees. These curricula are organized around four major scientific domains:

- Science & Technology
 - Law, Political Science, Economics, Management
 - Life & Health Sciences
 - Social & Human Sciences

A large range of qualifications are possible: 150 Bachelor (including vocational) programs, over 250 Master specialties, 115 national diplomas in health, as well as a national diploma in oncology. The university has also developed a wide range of international study programs that are taught in English (or other languages) and that offer students the possibility of studying abroad and/or completing joint or double degrees. A leading university in France for participation in the Erasmus Mundus program, the University of Bordeaux offers 20 EU-labeled study programs of excellence.

Research is organized around eleven departments:

- Social sciences of contemporary changes
- Behavior, organizations and policy evaluation
- Law and social transformations
- Bordeaux Neurocampus
- Biological and medical sciences

Public health

- Health sciences and technologies
- Environmental sciences
- Engineering and digital sciences
- Material and light sciences
- Archeological sciences

These departments group together 70 research laboratories that are under joint supervision with national research organizations. A Graduate Research School coordinates the entire field of doctoral studies in collaboration with the eight doctoral schools that ensure support and guidance for doctoral students. Three Graduate Research Programs have been launched within the domains of neuroscience, digital public health and light sciences and technologies.

STRENGTHS

- Rankings: the University of Bordeaux is ranked n°86 in the Times Higher Education Young University Ranking and 101-200 in the Times Higher Education Impact Ranking (2020), n°24 in Reuters Europe's Top 100 Innovative Universities (2019) and 201-300 within the Shanghai General Ranking (2020).
- Clusters of excellence: one of the main priorities of the University of Bordeaux is to promote the development of thematic clusters of excellence for research, training and knowledge transfer in the following fields: environmental sciences, neuroscience, advanced materials, archaeology, optics & lasers, computer sciences, translational research and advanced imaging, public health & cardiology.
- Industrial partnerships: with the various local economic sectors: aeronautics, space, chemistry, health, IT, optic/laser, forestry, wine.

LOCATION

The University of Bordeaux has one of the largest campuses (187 hectares) in Europe. It is composed of several sites that are located near to the city and that offer a broad range of services and amenities. 135 student associations exist and participate in the organization of a wide range of cultural activities throughout the academic year. A campus of excellence for sports as well, since 2010 Bordeaux is the n°1 French university for sports, ranking n°1 within Europe.

TECHNICIEN SUPÉRIEUR

Plus de 240 000 étudiants sont inscrits dans les sections de techniciens supérieurs pour l'obtention du Brevet de Technicien Supérieur (BTS) proposé dans 88 spécialités. Dans tous les secteurs d'activité se développent des fonctions nouvelles d'encadrement technique associées au travail des ingénieurs, des chercheurs ou des cadres supérieurs administratifs, financiers ou commerciaux. Le diplôme national de Brevet de Technicien Supérieur répond à ces besoins en qualifications et compétences avec pour objectif une insertion professionnelle directe.



Le cursus du BTS est construit sur un socle commun de compétences professionnelles, technologiques et générales identifiées pour l'obtention du diplôme et déclinées par spécialité. En deux ans, le BTS permet d'acquérir une qualification professionnelle dans les professions industrielles et commerciales, l'agriculture ou dans les activités de service ou encore dans celles relevant des arts appliqués. Les compétences acquises par la formation d'un BTS répondent à la mondialisation des échanges et des systèmes productifs qui exigent aujourd'hui des connaissances technologiques approfondies, des savoir-faire opérationnels et des capacités de management.

Les sections de techniciens supérieurs les plus attractives sont majoritairement dans le domaine des services. Une étude a par ailleurs montré le fort taux d'insertion professionnelle du BTS, objectif de ce diplôme, même s'il peut être aussi un tremplin vers la poursuite d'études. L'admission en BTS est sélective, sur dossier.

POURQUOI ÊTRE CANDIDAT À UN BTS ?

- Une formation professionnelle courte (* 2 années d'études supérieures)
 - Le BTS est préparé en deux ans après un Baccalauréat ou équivalent dans un lycée public ou privé, ou un centre de formation professionnelle.
- Une spécialisation dans un domaine professionnel
 - La formation associe des cours théoriques et des enseignements pratiques dispensés par des professionnels.
- Une insertion rapide et directe dans la vie active
- La découverte de l'entreprise
 - Les stages de formation sont organisés sous la responsabilité des établissements de formation et font l'objet d'une convention avec l'entreprise.
- L'accompagnement
 - L'étudiant bénéficie en BTS d'un stage de 14 à 18 semaines réparties sur toute l'année et encadré par un tuteur professionnel.

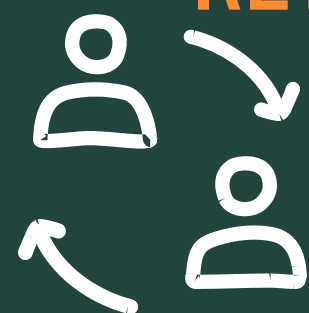

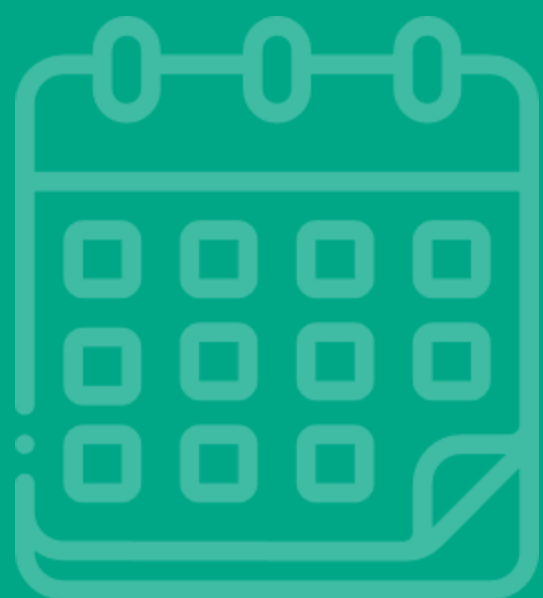

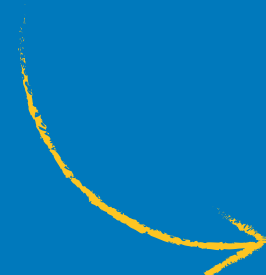
